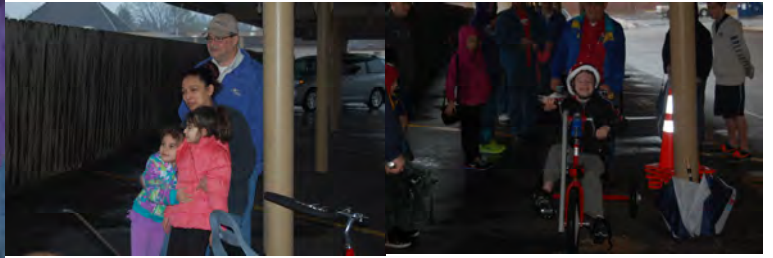


Presentation at Apex Fitness

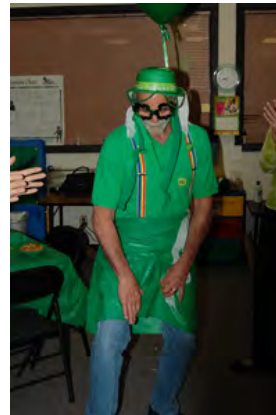
poured rain all morning. Their families were very happy and are looking forward to getting good use out of the Trykes.



St. Patrick's Day Party

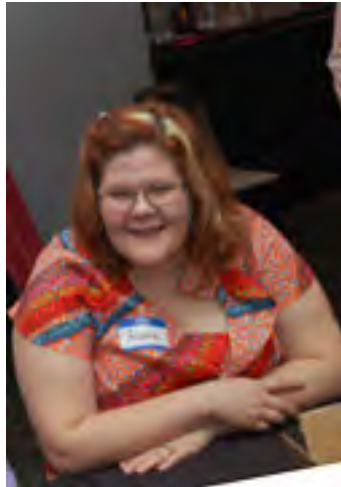

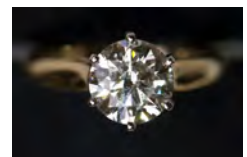
