own tryke which should help to strengthen her muscles. She is familiar with the trykes as she uses them in her therapy at St. Francis which is one of our evaluation sites.



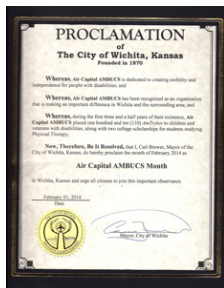
The second AmTryke went to Eleanor. She is

Poker Run Check Presentation

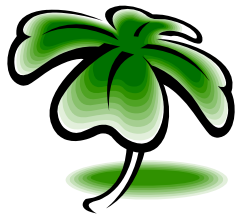

ful cause and the club is honored to be able to spend a day with them. Make sure to invite friends and family out for this day and reunite with our recipients as well.

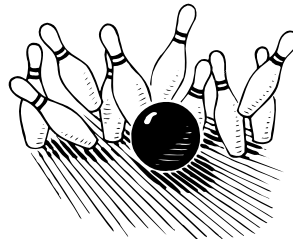
Special Guest Speaker
