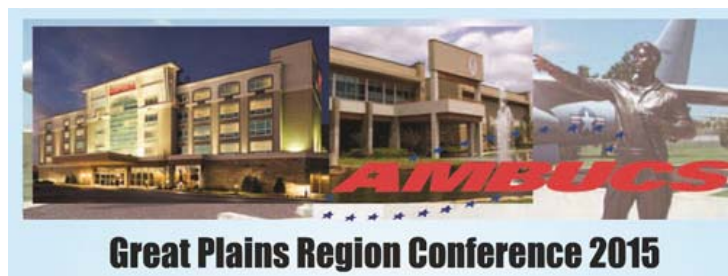
Great Plains Region Conference
